School Support Staff First agreement in principle at the CSQ

After 11 months of negotiations, the Fédération du personnel de soutien scolaire (FPSS-CSQ) late last night reached an agreement in principle at the sectoral table for French school board support staff.

“We led negotiations with a government that was determined to turn back the clock on our working conditions. We succeeded in stopping it, thanks to the solidarity of our members and the historic mobilization they have shown in recent weeks. Better yet, we made some significant gains that will benefit all the 27,000 members that we represent,” proudly stated **Éric Pronovost**, President of the FPSS-CSQ. The agreement will be put to the members at general assemblies.
